Nowadays, ethnic Koreans live in large numbers in sovereign Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and other former Soviet republics. The aim of this work is an excursus into the history of Korean Diasporas in the republics of former USSR since the beginning of the migration, the struggle against Japanese interventions during the civil war in Russia, the forced displacement to Central Asian region, describing the extraordinary phenomenon of the Korean agricultural cooperatives, describing overall contribution of the ethnic Koreans to the development of Central Asia and describing several nowadays diasporas, including not yet thoroughly researched diasporas of Koreans in Belarus, Estonia and Ukraine.
