

Diploma work „Family as factor influencing socially-pathological behaviour of the child“ is compiled theoretically and scientifically.

Theoretical part deals with family and its relations concerned. Preliminarily it describes some pathological phenomena which significantly influence the development of the family. Basic functions of family as well as its failures are described. Also some of undesirable manifestations of behaviour of particular members of family are described. Theoretical part of diploma work shows the relation between disfunction of the family and inception of pathological behaviour of individuals. Suicide, misuse of drugs, problems connected with delinquent behaviour and penitentiary treatment are evaluated as the most dangerous for human and for the society as a whole.

As conclusions are followed by empirical part. Empirical part examines number of some family factors in anamnesis of young imprisoned persons. Particularly informations about completeness and functionality of families of these individuals are examined.

Furthermore this part concentrates on monitoring of emotional relation of parents to their delinquent children and at the same time the way of upbringing is monitored.

The summary comprises both theoretical conclusions as well as conclusions based on informations coming from the investigation.
