Abstract (in English):

The aim of this thesis is to describe the composition of Josef Skvorecky's novels from the eighties, Scherzo capriccioso (Dvorak in love) and Nevesta z Texasu (The Bride of Texas). Both texts have a very specific composition construction based on several story lines which are divided in shorter sections and mixed with each other. It is done differently in both novels. In Scherzo capriccioso we primarily examine composition in terms of chapters, narators and genres. Our main interest in Nevesta z Texasu is the connection of partial story sections which is based on their story scheme. Lastly we describe the purpose of different fonts used in both novels.
