

Abstract

The bachelor thesis focuses on the use of numerals in the first part of new (neology) compound-words. Compound-words were excerpted from dictionaries *Slovník neologizmů 1, 2* and from the Czech neology database *Neomat*. On the basis of that material it was described which particular numerals and which types of numerals are used in neologisms, which formal restrictions and variants in word-formation bases (such as the origin of language of second parts, competition of morpheme variants) can occur. Compound-words were assessed with regard to their word-class validity, way of word-formation and semantic-syntactic relations between their components. The second parts of compound-words were also considered, as well as the thematic sphere of use of compound-words and their potential marked character.
