Abstract

This Bachelor thesis is focused on Mongolians permanently living in Czech republic and continuity of their cultural traditions. This thesis is divided into two parts - theoretical part and analytical/research part. Theoretical part consists of research of literature related to Mongolian's cultural traditions and celebration of their national holidays Tsagaan Sar and Naadam.
