

Abstract

The primary subject of this bachelor thesis is to mediate the life story of Eva Mändlová, Roubíčková. Its second, central part surveys this Jewish woman's life path from her early childhood, through her deportation to the Terezin ghetto to the long-awaited return home. In a broader context the work strives to give the present audience an understanding of the everyday life of Jews, which was deeply affected by the events of World War II. For that purpose it uses not only the available historical records, but also authentic testimonies of Holocaust survivors. Its introductory part follows the footsteps of the Jewish population in Žatec region from its first mention until the present time.
