Course of defence: The Defense Committee Chair welcomed all participants and initiated the defense by verbal statements confirming (i) that a satisfactory number of Defense Committee Members were present, (ii) that the student fulfilled all the requirements as listed in the Study and Examination Code of Charles University including showing the appropriate documents.
The final-defense took place online on the Microsoft Teams platform with the participation of five committee members, Ales Marsal, his supervisor and approximately 40 students.
The Defense Committee Chair introduced all committee members and asked Ales Marsal to present his dissertation thesis. Ales Marsal shortly described the main topics, methodologies, and findings of the dissertation. Afterwards, Ales Marsal focused on the fourth chapter “Determinants of Fiscal Multipliers Revisited” in more detail. After reading the referees’ (appointed by the Graduation Council) comments, an open discussion followed. No questions were raised by Defense Committee Members or members of the audience. During the Defense Committee voting, Ales Marsal left the online session and re-connected to hear the defense result.
The Committee states that Ales Marsal successfully defended his thesis and is entitled to get a PhD title from Charles University. All presented Committee members agreed with such a decision. The Defense Committee confirmed this record in the form of per rollam voting within the next two days.
