This bachelor's thesis deals with the secondary school youths' awareness of contraception and attitudes towards planned parenthood. The thesis points to a lack of supply of information on venereal and sexually transmitted diseases and insufficient information on contraception.

In the theoretical part the terms planned parenthood, contraception and overview of contraceptive methods, adolescence, gender, and also the topic of education were clarified.

In the empirical part we compared knowledge of contraception and family planning among students of a secondary school of nursing, a secondary technical school, and a gymnasium. We investigated what kind of contraception is preferred by students and their attitude towards family planning. The first source and level of information regarding sex education and contraception were investigated as well.

The method of quantitative research using a non-standardized questionnaire has been used and the results processed into graphs and tables afterwards.
