Contribution

The intuition for the research question in this thesis is the following. Electronic records of sales (EET) should have brought a portion of the economy from the “shadow” (basically untaxed) domain to the “white” (properly taxed) domain. Did it happen, and if yes, what was the percentage in reality? The answer is important for three reasons at least. First, the statistical office needs to compute GDP properly, i.e. it needs proper estimates of both the white and the shadow economy. It’s notoriously difficult to estimate the size of the shadow economy, so such estimates are very rough and are not updated often. In comparison, it’s much easier and faster to observe changes in the size of the white economy. Now if a part of the economy moves from the shadow to the white domain, the effect should not be interpreted as GDP growth. But because the statistical office does not observe the decrease in the shadow economy, GDP growth is precisely what is reported. Second, the “whitening” of the economy tells us something about the efficiency of EET. Third, the proportion of the move from the shadow to the white domain is also useful for future computations of the size of the shadow economy. As far as I know, no one has tackled this research question anywhere in the world. Monika Besedova uses up-to-date methodology, synthetic control method (with the most recent extensions) to compute the counterfactual Czech economy without EET. She finds that EET increased GDP (statistically) by 2.3 % and therefore that the Czech Statistical Office utterly failed in capturing the move from the shadow to the white domain – in effect, it double-counted portions of the economic activity.
