The topic that my colleague was working on is current worldwide, and I think it is important regularly inform the professional public about the results of the survey.

The results of the experimental part, especially the organization of research and analysis went very well. The only thing I would point out is the low number of probands, based on which we cannot generalize the results of the survey.
