## **Abstract**

Archaeology is one of the scientific disciplines that are very easily subject to trends in societal discourse. The researchers themselves are more or less interested in adapting their interpretations of archaeological sources to the current social climate. We know from the past that the archaeology had to be adjusted according to a specific political task. In the past, archaeology has come to defend various nationalistic claims, especially territorial ones.

My bachelor thesis is a case study from the South Slavic area. On a case of the socalled Bosnian pyramids and the interpretation of early medieval Croatian burial grounds, I am showing that archaeology is still applicable to national requirements in the conditions of an unstable socio-political situation.
