Abstract (english):

This bachelor's thesis deals with the activities of extraordinary people's courts in Kutná Hora and Mladá Boleslav, focusing mainly on the activities of the Public Prosecutor's Office and public prosecutors as such in the above-mentioned extraordinary people's courts. It deals with the general characteristics and specific features of these extraordinary people's courts. Their origin, development, organization and functioning with regard to the aspect of popularity in these courts in the form of judges from the people and their issues. Then it will focus specifically on public prosecution offices - on their staffing and related difficulties, eg in communication with district national committees.
