

ABSTRACT

The Czech scouting organisation (Junák – český skaut) has an elaborated system for training of active volunteers. Focal point of the system lies in courses that qualify their absolvents for education of children and leading of scout troops and camps. The topic of this bachelor thesis is a new form of an educational event, not yet embodied in the training system. This relevance of this form – a *Weekend for unit boards* – was tested in 2019. The *Weekend for unit boards* emerged with the idea of cooperative education of scout troops. The thesis concentrates on the preparation of the event and will include the description of its implementation based on literature and supporting documentation of the Czech scouting organisation. Main source of information about the preparation of the *Weekend for unit boards* are experiences and opinions of the organizers, which were identified through participant observation. The aim of the thesis is to analyse and assess main aspects of the preparation and implementation of the *Weekend for unit boards*, so it can be a source of information for other trainers inspired by this event. The thesis also discusses whether the Weekend for unit boards fulfils the opportunities expected by the Czech scouting organisation.
