

Abstract in English

My thesis follows up a potential influence of transhumanism on reflexive planning of people according to a Czech transhumanist community in regard of Person-In-Environment theory and postmodern changes in the society. A conceptual part contains chapters about transhumanism, areas that transhumanism focuses on, H+ technologies, potential, community and reflexive planning. In a framework of a qualitative research, my data were gathered using semi-structured interviews on topics reflexivity of a human actor, decision making, work with information, power, existential dimension of life and sorrow and anxiety related to life changes and losses. According to the obtained data the biggest potential for reflexive planning can be found in examining possibilities of using artificial intelligence, collective consciousness and virtual hedonism, all that with regard to necessity of fight for human rights and democracy and economical breakthrough, which could result in removal of social inequality.
