Contribution

The ongoing trend towards digitalisation was clearly intensified by the Covid-19 crisis. In this context, e-commerce has been rapidly growing and supported also by lockdowns of many economies changing people's behaviour patterns and shifting purchases from shops to online platforms. The thesis investigates on the development of the e-commerce market including the impact of COVID-19. This is the area relatively unexplored so far.

Methods

The thesis use the company valuation theory and event study framework to proceed with the conducted empirical analysis. Although, it does not deal with any advanced empirical methods, the conducted event study provides an interesting inside into the effect of the Covid-19 outbreak on e-commerce markets.

Literature

The academic literature in the area of e-commerce is relatively limited. However, the author managed to reflect in her work on the relevant sources.

Manuscript form

The thesis is reasonably structured, but the formatting could be improved. In particular, charts and tables could be aligned. Moreover, some improvements in the drafting/proof read could be beneficial for a reader.

Summary and suggested questions for the discussion during the defense

Overall, the thesis deals with the interesting topic not extensively covered in the existing academic literature. Despite the methodology used is relatively basic, it brings some new insight reflecting on the ongoing COVID crisis. Some improvements could be made on the manuscript in terms of the language and formatting. Moreover, the certain parts of the thesis has a tendency to resemble a business report style rather than an academic work. However, in my view, the thesis fulfils the requirements for a master thesis at IES, Faculty of Social Sciences, Charles University, I recommend it for the defence and suggest a grade E.

The results of the Urkund analysis do not indicate significant text similarity with other available sources (25%, but the similarities are mostly referenced to the original sources).

The author could further elaborate on the following questions:

- Based on the thesis, what are the implications for the e-commerce in the future in the context of the current crisis?
- What could be expected for the future development of e-commerce in terms of market concentration?
