

Abstract

This thesis deals with evidence in International Arbitration. The introductory part of the thesis includes an analysis of the rules of evidence in the Czech Republic, Germany and England. The following is a comparison with a list of identities and differences. The second part contains analysis of the provisions of the IBA Rules on the Taking of Evidence in International Arbitration. The aim of the thesis is to evaluate whether IBA Rules on the Taking of Evidence in International Arbitration mitigate conflicts that arise from different rules of evidence in common law and civil law.
