

## **Abstract**

This thesis is focused on passing of risk of accidental loss and destruction of goods during international sale. The main objective is to fulfil the hypothesis concerning the the regulation of passing of risk in two main sources of its regulation, the Incoterms clauses and the UN Convention on the International Sale of Goods, so called the Vienna Convention, and their mutual relationship in the regulation of this institute. Thesis also contains an analysis of the term danger and its various types. The second part is focused on the revision of Incoterms 2020, comparison of the passing of risk under Incoterms and the Vienna Convention, their similarities and differences and the possibility of their interaction.
