

This thesis focuses on the institutional aspect of the selection of constitutional judges in the Czech Republic and in Slovakia, the personal aspect of selection, i.e. identification of the groups of recruitment and requirements and qualities of the judges. The thesis also focuses on the process, i.e. procedural aspects within which the key authorities (presidents and parliaments) compare and choose individual candidates. Based on this analysis, the student will identify strengths and weaknesses of both systems, which could lead to paralysis of the court in question.
