This bachelor's thesis studies the topic of awareness of mothers and their daughters aged between 12 and 14 years about the prevention of cervical cancer. The study is divided into a theoretical and an empirical part. The theoretical part addresses the anatomy of the female reproductive system, transmission, treatment, and prevention of cervical cancer, following section of the theoretical part focuses on nursing care for a woman with cervical cancer. At the end of the theoretical part, the concepts of adolescence and health literacy are described.

The empirical section incorporates the resulting knowledge of mothers and their daughters aged between 12 and 14 years about the prevention of cervical cancer, the anatomy of the female reproductive system, most common risk factors, vaccines, and the importance of preventive gynecological examinations. A quantitative questionnaire was used for the research.
