

The work focuses on the field of neology and language contacts. It observes and analyses the way of morphologic - word-forming adaptation of the lexical units of foreign origin for the adapting languages in the first phase of the adaptation process. The work is devoted to the study of the adaptation of the lexical units of foreign origin for the adapting languages in the first phase of the adaptation process. We work with Czech, Russian and Bulgarian origin, but to trace more general patterns of their assimilation in the adapting languages and the ways, how could the inflow of the word borrows influence the structural features of the adapting language. Thus, we are getting to the issue that may have also more general theoretical validity. The distinctive examples of that are such cases as the phenomena summed up by Kostomarov under the name *izafet*. That way, within the scope of the study of synchronous dynamics, the work contributes to the view of innovation processes, conditioned by the inter-linguistic contacts.
