

Abstract

The main aim of this thesis is to discuss the influence of administrative borders on spatial polarization. An area divided by administrative borders, was in focus. It was verified, that the most peripheral municipalities lie on these borders. Within the context of cumulative polarization after 1989, we were awaiting the increasing of the peripheral municipalities. By contrast, the peripheral area has diminished. As the next aim, a development potential was disclosed in term of cooperation and relationship. Though the administrative border is not seen as a barrier, it influences the cooperation of the community. Moreover, the influence of administrative border on regional development was interpreted by developmental documents analysis and questionnaire analysis.
