

## **ABSTRACT**

### **Title:**

Tourism in Radhošť massif in sustainable development borders

### **Aim:**

This graduation paper should chart the actual state of the tourism near the Radhošť mountain and bring the concept of sustainable development of the tourism with respect to environmental protection

### **Method:**

During the problem solving especially following methods have been used:

- results of own data collection and field survey
- tutorials with addressed external authorities
- analysis of documents, written materials and websites
- results of scientific reaserches from CHKO Beskydy as well as from outside
- application of experience from Czech Republic and from abroad

### **Results:**

Following points result from our survey:

- visit rate is mostly dependent upon weather conditions, weather forecast and on the fact whether it is holiday, bank holiday, week day or week end
- tourists are mostly satisfied with the actual state of environmental protection, criticising mostly transport conditions and information availability
- the main part of tourists come by car, majority of tourist attend the ridge around noon
- local people prefer conservation of the landscape character while those coming from longer distance emphasize air protection and recyclation
- development of tourism and environmental protection are not preclusive with respect to the area management plan
