

# Abstract

The thesis "Integration of children from the Children's Home in to the society" is focused on young people leaving the Children's Home. The main objective was to describe the possibilities which are available to those young people leaving Children's Home including the descriptions of the factors which influenced these possibilities. This work targets the initial position of young people during the integration into the society as well as the ability of the Children's Homes to prepare them for this integration adequately. The theoretical part focuses on the background provided to these children by the state and on the projects raised from the initiative of the nongovernmental nonprofit organizations to fill in the gap in the assistance to these children. The practical part summarizes the conclusions from the theoretical part by finding out how all these processes work in practice. The interviews with young people from Children's Homes and from Halfway Houses have brought the interesting survey about these people feelings about their leaving the current house, and their possible doubts, also if there is a real support of the educators from the Children's Homes. By the end of the work I reach a view that there is not a whole care for the former nurse-children and the quality of preparing for the life differs from the particular Children's Homes. During the interviews I have also realized that there is something common for all these people (and so does for the majority of children, who went over the Institutional care) = there is no doubt that the life in the Children's Homes is very different than the life and growing in the common family. Logically those people could have more difficulties in integration problems into the society.
