Bachelor thesis explores the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic crisis on well-being of social workers working with migrants in Prague, Central Bohemian Region, South Moravian Region and Pilsen Region. Theoretical part of the thesis defines basic terms and provides theoretical anchoring of the thesis. The empirical part of the thesis is represented by a qualitative research. The data have been collected via individual online or face-to-face interviews with social workers working in social services with migrants as a primary target group. The conclusion of the thesis introduces recommendations for supervisors on effective mental health care for their employees.
