Course of defence: The Defense Committee Chair welcomed all participants. In 25 minutes the student presented her thesis on The Conformity of the Managerial and Democratic Imperatives of Governance in Non-Governmental Organizations (Comparison between Berlin, Cairo, and Prague) and shortly described the main topic, theories, methodology, and findings of the dissertation. Then opponent prof. El Baradei shortly highlighted her comments to the dissertation and put the question on criteria and reason of choice of NGOs, the basic overview of good governance indicators in all three countries and the limits of concepts and the recommendation that are positive but not practical. The supervisor doc. Frič shortly commented on the thesis and the good student's approach to writing thesis. Then he summarized the report of the opponent doc. Pospíšilová who had methodological remarks. Chair of the Board asked the student to comment the remarks from reviews. Student briefly answered the opponents' comments. She described how it would be possible to improve the research in the future. Prof. Veselý asked on sampling of organisation. Student answered. Doc. Mansfeldová asked on the role NGO chains in the students research and its impact on the results of the research. Student explained how she included this aspect in her results.
