OVERALL ASSESSMENT

The thesis addresses an interesting and relevant topic - yield curve modelling. The thesis is competently written; standard theory is appropriately described and explained with many references to the current literature. The theoretical background is strong and brings the main contribution of the thesis - a creation of a complete framework that enables to analyze yield curves. The applicability of the models was further demonstrated by setting risk scenarios and framework for the detection of structural breaks. The form of the manuscript is exemplary and highlights quality of the thesis.

All relevant comments given by the supervisor were incorporated into the text during the process of writing. However, possible defense questions could be concerned with a) latent factor – how to interpret it in the principal component model analysis, b) what may be the intuition behind the common factors in regional yield curves of selected countries.

Further work could be focused on yield curve modelling with employing macroeconomic variables, which could bring additional insight on regional yield curves.

Based on the high quality of the submitted diploma thesis, I recommend accepting the thesis with **excellent** evaluation and awarding **distinction from the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences**.
