Cleft lip and palate is one of the most common congenital developmental defects . Morphological character defect has severe negative functional effects on swallowing , breathing, chewing and speech formation . aesthetically , the This is a significant handicap facial triad that affects the most overall facial appearance . Approximately 15 % of children have a defect associated with other disabilities , but isolated defect is neither lethal nor associated with mental failure .

It is clear that the defect is a problem both health

psychological and socio-economic . Therefore , the issue of treatment of patients

with cleft recognized worldwide as so important that in this respect
