The bachelor thesis focuses on the development of the relationship of the Western society towards body and corporeality by means of short insights. The insights focus on the ages of the Old Testament, Ancient Greece, the time of the first centuries and Patristics. The last two chapters of the introduction to the topic explain the approaches towards body and corporeality in Thomas Aquinas and René Descartes. The main part of the bachelor thesis interprets the views on body and corporeality in O. Clément, L. M. Chauvet and J. Moltmann. The conclusion points at a few similar approaches towards body and corporeality among the three theologians. The three approaches are also questioned and tried with respect to lives of ordinary Christians.
