

PUBLICATIONS OF PROFESSOR LIBUŠE DUŠKOVÁ, NONAGERIAN



With bibliographic information accessible nowadays via Google Scholar and other databases, it may seem redundant to compile a list of publications. Nevertheless, as the bibliographies and their supplements documenting Professor Libuše Dušková's work are dispersed throughout issues of *Linguistica Pragensia* spanning the past thirty years, and have not been updated for over a decade, it seems only practical to collate and update all the information, especially as the journal is now an open access platform.

Making the information widely available is intended as a modest retroactive act to celebrate the ninetieth birthday of *Linguistica Pragensia*'s long-time Chief Editor, without whose erudition, professionalism and dedication the journal would not be enjoying the high reputation for its service to academia. As is always the case with Professor Dušková, however, the list of her publications is also highly instructive, be it as a source of inspiration, as information on the development of English linguistics, or as a marvellous example of unrivalled steady achievement and influence in the field.

Technically, this compilation builds on the previous lists published in this journal: Nosek (1991), Malá and Šaldová (2000), Čermák (2005), and Brůhová (2010), which have been checked against available databases and supplemented with the titles published thereafter. In addition, information is provided of earlier papers reprinted in Professor Dušková's monographs *Studies in the English Language I* and *II* (Dušková 1999a,b) and *From Syntax to Text: The Janus Face of Functional Sentence Perspective* (Dušková 2015) to facilitate their accessibility.
