Abstract

This bachelor thesis aims to identify and compare the workload of social workers in community and non-community services for people with psychotic mental illness. It is divided into two parts. In the theoretical part, psychotic mental illnesses, institutional and community care and a social worker who works with people with psychotic mental illness are characterized with the help of professional literature.
