The bachelor's thesis explores the alzheimer's center staff's view of encountering death. The work is composed of a theoretical and practical part. The first part deals with Alzheimer's disease, its overall issues and the life associated with it. It also mentions dying, death and the elements associated with it, including grieving. In the practical part, responses are recorded from interviewed staff who, in addition to general feelings, were asked about attitudes and opinions about dying, death and Alzheimer's disease. The practical part was implemented using anonymous and voluntary questionnaires. The results of quantitative research are then shown in graphs. Four subgoals, which were met, were established. The results can be used in teaching practice or for further research.
