This bachelor thesis analyzes the quality of care provided to diabetic foot syndrome patients.

The theoretical part deals with the quality of Nursing care, diabetes mellitus – characteristics, etiopathogenesis, forms of diabetes, diagnosis, treatment, acute and late complications. This part also deals with diabetic foot syndrome – characteristics, diagnosis, treatment, and discusses new trends in wound healing, prevention and psychological aspects in patients.

The empirical part is based on the results of research of an anonymous quantitative non-standardized questionnaire. A total of 41 respondents with diabetic foot syndrome participated in the research study. The questionnaire detects the basic information about patients and their perceptions of the diabetology department's care quality.
