

Processes of globalisation, advances in communication and transportation technologies, economical and political instability, and of course famine and wars, they all cause increasing migration flows in the world. We made 22 interviews with immigrants from different parts of the world, all interviews were then qualitatively analysed. The results of my research proved that foreigner's adaptation process for Czech culture is individual and depends on many factors like internal (personality) and external ones (attitude and behaviour of Czech majority).
