

## **Abstract**

This bachelor thesis focuses on specifics of the part of speech of interjections in Portuguese language with taking into account possible parallels with the Czech language. The thesis consists of two parts, the theoretical one and the practical one. The first part focuses on the description and characteristics of interjections from different grammatical points of view. In particular, it deals with the formal side of this part of speech and with its meaning.

A questionnaire in the second part should reveal any possible differences of the use of interjections between the European and Brazilian variants of Portuguese. The questionnaire is divided into two areas. The first area asks about everyday situations where native speakers are supposed to react with interjections. In the second area respondents fill in the sounds of animals and corresponding verbs to that.
