

The diploma thesis " Mary of Magdala in the Bible and in the Christian Tradition" is divided into three parts. The first, key part, is based on biblical text, primarily the New Testament. It analyzes in detail the attributes ascribed to the person of Mary of Magdala. The second part reviews selected non-canonic literature in which the name of Mary of Magdala appears. Based on the texts of the Gospel of Thomas, the Gospel of Philip, the Gospel of Mary, the Conversation with the Savior and the Pistis Sofia, the attributes ascribed to her by this literature are again analyzed. The third part discusses the most recent research of the early Christian era and their connection with Mary of Magdala. The conclusion summarizes the current views of her and how her life story is captured in literary form through contemporary eyes, i. e. from the viewpoint of contemporary authors.
