Holy Trinity church in Klášterec nad Ohří

Abstract

Holy Trinity Church was built in the mid-sixties of the 17th century. The construction was ordered by Count Michael Oswald Thun and it was a part of a Baroque rebuilding of his estate in Klášterec. Among the other contruction projects were e.g. the reconstruction of the castle, building of *sala terrena* and founding of extensive gardens, decorated with sculptures from the early Baroque sculptor Jan Brokoff. Plans for the church were developed by a significant architect Carlo Lurago and construction was realized by builder Rossi de Luca. The plans, however, differ from the final form of the church. In my thesis i summarize the knowledge about the church I found and try to look into drew defign of towerd facade of the church from architect Lurago. And the goal of my work is to connect his design with similar buildings.
