Abstract

This thesis deals to analyze the three well-known Jesus Christ's routes which are mentioned in the Gospels of the New Testament.

The first part of the thesis there is a historical description of the person of Jesus Christ and his humanity. The second part contains a description of selected ways of the Jesus Christ' life. That is an escape to Egypt before Herod the Great. The next one describes the route from Jerusalem via Nazareth to Capernaum.
