4. Additional commentary and evaluation, questions for the defense:

The student did not sufficiently consult the work. The theoretical part of the thesis is processed in a clear manner and the chapters follow logically. But the described pharmacotherapy, physical therapy procedures and prognosis do not reflect current trends. Some literary sources are not properly cited. The text of the general part lacks references to tables.

The special part is processed in a clear manner. The examination and therapeutic procedures used correspond to the content of the bachelor's degree. For the PIR with stretching technique, he is listed incorrectly as the author of Lewit. Then the PIR technique was applied to shortened muscles. Furthermore, the patient's prognosis is missing. Despite the above-mentioned shortcomings, the submitted bachelor's thesis meets the set goals and required requirements.

Questions for the defense:

Why was the orbicularis oris muscle not examined during the facial muscles examination?

How do you see the patient's prognosis?
