Course of the examination:	The student introduced the thesis, including its treatment of threats, placed the thesis in the broader literature, explained the theoretical framework based on Keohane's liberal institutionalism, and outlined the data used. The committee asked how the thesis explained the role of multilateral frameworks as opposed to the individual agency of states. The candidate argued that state agency is critical and more important than multilateral frameworks. The committee agreed that the defense was strong and that, despite some minor concerns from the second reader, the thesis was still in the upper excellent group and graded it an A.
