This bachelor thesis deals with the awareness of youth regarding the risks of early

initiation of sexual activity. It is structured into theoretical and empirical parts.

The theoretical section includes chapters on the period of adolescence and sexual

education. It also addresses selected sexually transmitted diseases (hereinafter referred to as

STDs), including their history, prevention, and diagnosis. The thesis also discusses barrier

contraception and the concept of sexual education.

The empirical part of this thesis is carried out through a non-standardized quantitative

questionnaire survey among 7th and 8th-grade students, aged 13-15. The main aim of this

part is to assess the extent of knowledge and awareness of primary school students regarding

the risks of early initiation of sexual activity.
