

Abstract

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This bachelor thesis deals with the perspective of general nurses on the provision of palliative hospice care.

The theoretical part presents the basic characteristics of palliative care and its division, the division of hospice care and an introduction to the Hospice of Agnes of Bohemia in Červený Kostelec, mentions the possibilities of nurses' education in palliative care and burnout syndrome in the provision of palliative care.

The empirical part shows the results of qualitative research, which was carried out in the form of semi-structured interviews with female respondents. The aim of the research was to map the attitudes of general nurses towards working in palliative care. How the respondents view the provision of care, their motivation to perform the profession, their experience in palliative care and their psychohygiene to prevent burnout syndrome.
