# Implementace a účinnost KiVa programu na základních školách v České republice

Implementation and effectiveness of the KiVa programme in primary schools in the Czech Republic

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#### Abstract

The aim of the thesis is to find out how the participating control primary schools in the Czech Republic implemented the KiVa programme during the pilot year and how effective it was from the perspective of KiVa team members. The author fulfils this aim through answering two main research questions.

The thesis contains theoretical and empirical part. In the theoretical part the author deals with two main areas. These are bullying in primary schools in the Czech Republic and the KiVa programme. The empirical part describes the actual course of the research investigation in primary schools in the Czech Republic with a focus on the KiVa programme, including the research methodology, the analysis of the data obtained from the quantitative and qualitative investigation and the presentation of the results from this mixed research. The thesis also includes recommendations for further practice. These recommendations are addressed both to the non-profit organization Schola Empirica, which sponsors the entire KiVa program, and to elementary schools that are actively involved in the program or will be involved in this antibullying prevention program in the future.
