

Abstract

In this bachelor thesis, research is carried out on transport services, and in particular on factors influencing the transport needs and behaviour of the population in the region called the Four Frontiers. It is an inner periphery within the Czech Republic, located on the border of the Karlovy Vary, Ústí nad Labem, Pilsen and Central Bohemia regions. The region has its own specifics and attractions. In the first part of the thesis the definition of the region itself, the internal differentiation by regions and also the transport flows and the possibilities of choosing a suitable means of transport were made. The first part is followed by the research itself, in which I will get to the factors influencing transport. The research was carried out in various forms, both in the form of a simple census and in the form of a questionnaire that ascertained the mindset of the transported population. This work also suggests various solutions on how the existing public transport network could be improved.
