Course of defence: The student introduced general context, motivation and main focus of his thesis. The reviewers and commission expressed satisfaction with the thesis and mentioned a few comments. The comments were mainly of minor nature - some of the most important comments related to presentation of the thesis and especially clear definition and grasp of variables (conflict); and also to inclusion of a Chinese state-owned enterprise/company (SOE) which is different from other private (not state-owned) companies examined in the thesis. The student explained his understanding of conflict as organized protest. Related to China's SOE, the student commented on the inclusion of China' SOE.
