

Summary

Supervision by the State's Attorney in the Pretrial Criminal Proceedings.

I chose „ Supervision by the State's Attorney in Pretrial Criminal Procedure“ as the topic of my thesis because I would like to work as a state's attorney.

The topic is extensive, and as such I confined my research to the basic and essential themes.

Law No 265/2001 Digest, the new amendment to the Code of Criminal Proceedings has passed into law. This amendment is the source of my thesis.

I divided my work into several parts. In the first part I examine the position of the state's attorney in the criminal proceedings in general and I define the term „criminal trial proceedings“ and more specifically, „pretrial criminal proceedings“. I looked closer at the tasks of the state's attorney in the criminal trial proceedings. The core of my thesis is the description of the supervision by the State's Attorney before and after the pretrial criminal proceedings and shortened criminal proceedings.

In the conclusion I evaluate the the efficiency of the amendment of the Code of Criminal Procedure (No 265/2001) Digest.

I used as sources the Code of Criminal Procedure, law journals, textbooks of Criminal law, and articles authored by many of the outstanding Czech lawyers who participated in the above mentioned amendment.
