

Experience and perception supervision on OSPOD which is situated in Pilsen region

Abstract

The diploma thesis deals with the topic of supervision as a support tool for workers in the social and legal protection of children. Through qualitative research, the diploma thesis gives a comprehensive overview of the attitudes and experiences of the workers of the social and legal protection of children in relation to supervision in the Pilsen Region.

This diploma thesis focuses on the analysis of experience and perception of supervision among workers of social and legal protection of children in the Pilsen Region. The research uses a qualitative approach with semi-structured interviews, which allow a deeper insight into the individual experiences and attitudes of the informants.

The data is analyzed using grounded theory, which allows identifying key thematic areas such as helpful, unhelpful, and neutral aspects of supervision.

The results of this diploma thesis contribute to a better understanding of the importance of supervision as a professional development tool in the field of social and legal protection of children in the Pilsen Region.
