Individualized Education Plan is an educational document designed and developed to meet the individual educational needs of the children with special education needs. It contains the details of present status of the child's performance, goals, objectives, activities, additional supports and services for the child and also the criteria for determining his progress (Lee-Tarver, 2006). Collaboration between teachers, parents and professionals play a vital role while designing, developing and implementing the Individualized Education Plan (IEP).
