New systematics of intentional killing belongs undoubtedly among the most important changes brought by new Criminal Code. According to P. Šámal's and others' opinion, this new systematic allows distinguishing between criminal offenses which are identical in the result, i.e. human death, but at the same time they differ by the circumstances surrounding its commission.

The new legislation should be able to cover a large diversity of intentional killing.

The aim of this study was to analyze this new legal rules and make an assessment.

In the thesis I tried to define some of key terms of the new legislation and highlight differences among them, further I tried to define the relationship crime offence murder, its forms and the offense manslaughter. I also dealt with hearing of evidence in the connection with investigation of mentioned crimes and I tried to lay down possible problems which the practice could face.

It is obvious that the thesis can not cover up all information because of the scope of the work, and that is why the thesis does not cover some topics like for example euthanasia even if they are closely related.
