

The thesis *Circumstances and Consequences of the Destruction of the Historical Town Most* analyzes the circumstances and situation that arose after the destruction the historical town Most. The thesis approaches the topic via the description of the original situation, analysis of the consequences of the destruction and via outlining the possibilities of potential solutions of the current situation. Historical resources mapping the topic were used to describe the situation. The current state was analyzed via a field study and personal inventory that mapped attitudes of the participants who went through the situation. Potential proposals to solve the situations were outlined with the help of foreign case studies related to the topic. Czech cultural context was taken into an account for this purpose. The thesis suggests that the decision to destroy the old town Most has left severe and irreversible consequences in many aspects. The consequences are to be seen in the context of historical, cultural, ecological, psychological and sociological levels.
