

The aim of research work Sense of Family History as Part of Self-identity is mapping depth and extent of information that have respondents about their ancestors. At the same time I pursue how transmission rate of family history acts upon family system and upon individuals. The theoretical part concerns with the transmission forms of family heritage. In this research I'm writing about effect of traditional rituals on the family system as a whole but also on individuals. There are traditions of wedding, christening, funerals, the transmission of names, stories of family legends, myths and family taboos.

The objectives of this research work are: mapping of transmission conditions and knowledge depth of family history and looking for possible starting points for strengthening the sense of family history in the conditions of postmodern society in stories of respondents. To fulfill these objectives, I chose a qualitative method of data collection - a case study. The information were extracted with the help of interview method and analyzed by using open coding method.
